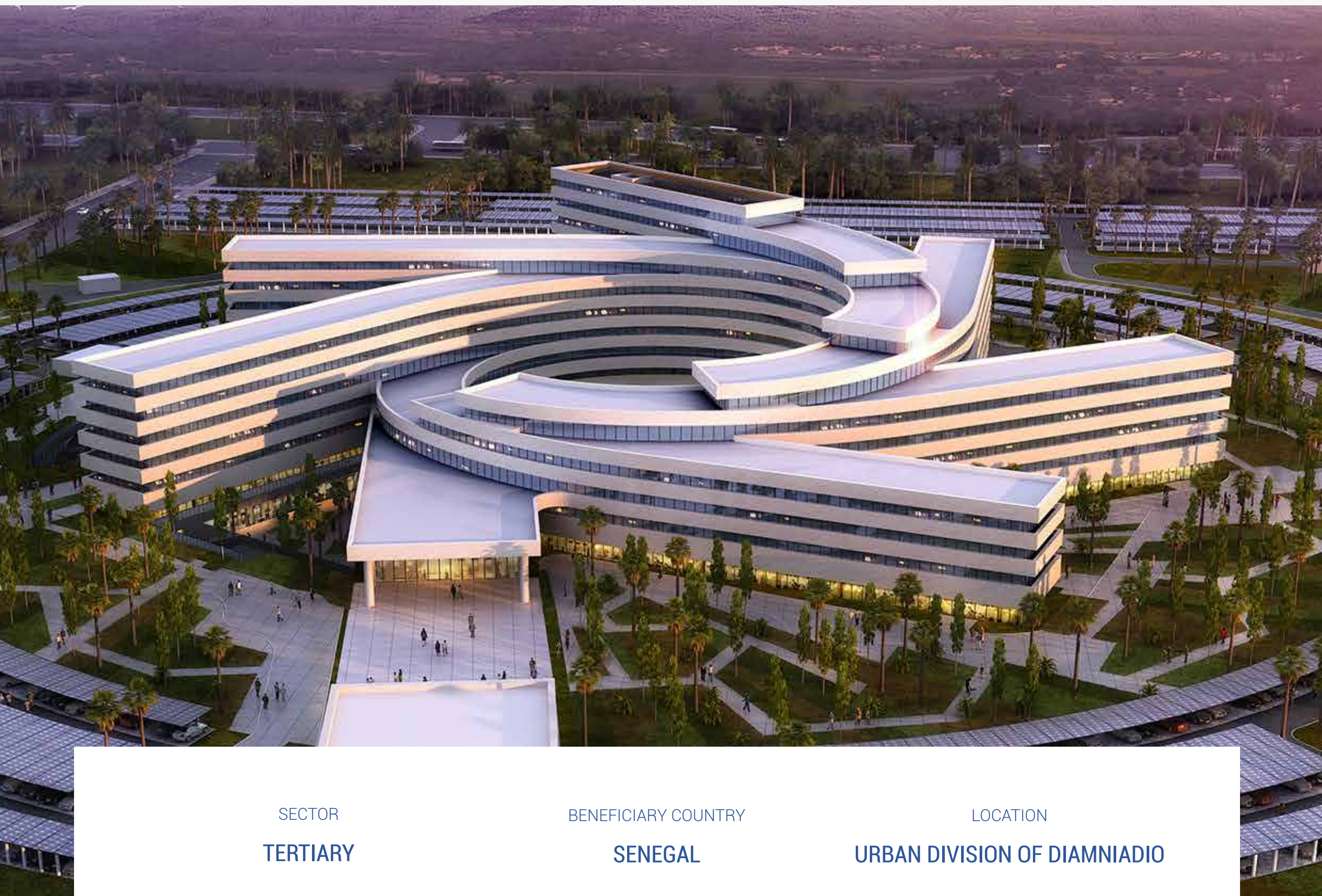

PRESENTATION

Born of a public-private partnership between the State of Senegal and the company Envol Partenariats Senegal, the project to build the United Nations house is at a total cost of 102 billion FCFA. The partnership agreement concerns the management by Envol Partenariats SN of the design, financing and implementation of the project. The construction of the United Nations House will be done in partnership with the company WIETC, having built the airports of Lomé and Brazzaville, the Ministerial City of Kinshasa, the Ministerial Sphere of Diamniadio with in particular the company Envol Immobilier.

THE PROJECT'S OBJECTIVES

- The launching of the 'One ONE' vision in Senegal;
- Enable better collaboration and efficient management of resources;
- Reduce rental and management costs for United Nations agencies in Senegal.

On a 12.75 ha site, the United Nations House will bring together on a single site the different agencies already present in Dakar. The challenge of this emblematic project is to illustrate the union of the agencies but also their independence and their influence on a national and regional scale.

The project is organized into four sectors necessary for the proper functioning of the agencies:

- *Tertiary (1814 workstations)*
- *Public (training, documentation center and workshops)*
- *Official (reception and conference)*
- *Support functions & support functions (catering, conviviality, services and logistics).*

A total of 32 United Nations agencies will be brought together in the building.
